Electing to bat first on a sticky wicket, the early batsmen all had difficulty with the new ball in fact the visitors were deep in trouble at 24 for 3 in 10 over's.

Our overseas spin twins Prav and Tosh both bagged a brace and Ferguslie ran out comfortable winners.
